

JOINT ELECTION AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made by Brooks County, of Falfurrias, Texas ("county) and the Brooks County Independent School District ("District"), for a Joint Election to be held on November 7, 2017, in which voters will vote on 7 amendments and one proposition

In consideration of the following mutual covenants and promises, County and District agree as follows:

1. EARLY VOTING DAY, DATES, HOURS, AND POLLING PLACE

The County and District agree to designate Ed Rachal Memorial Library located at 203 S. Calixto Mora Ave., Falfurrias, Texas, 78555 as the site for early voting by personal appearance.

Early voting shall commence on Monday, October 23, 2017, and terminate on November 3, 2017. Early voting shall be conducted in accordance with the Texas Election Code on the following days, dates, and hours during the early voting period:

2. APPOINTMENT OF JOINT EARLY VOTING CLERK AND EARLY VOTING BALLOT BOARD; DUTIES

Anna Maria Garcia is appointed as the Joint Early Voting Clerk for Brooks County and Brooks County ISD, and shall keep the polling place open for early voting during the days and hours described above. For the use of those voters who are entitled by law to vote early by mail, the Joint Early Voting Clerk shall provide each voter with an application for ballot by mail with instructions, shall receive the applications for early ballots to be voted by mail, shall issue ballots by mail to qualified voters, shall timely issue rejection letters to each applicant for ballot by mail who application shall be rejected, and perform any and all other duties related to early voting as prescribed by the Texas Election Code.

The County and District will enter into a joint contract with the Brooks County Elections Officer for all aspects of the 2017 general elections to be conducted by the Brooks County Elections Officer, which shall include the duty to appoint all election workers, perform all Early Voting duties, appoint all members of the Early Voting Ballot Board, provide all election equipment and materials, post and/or publish all required notices, and to provide all counting and tabulating services. The County and the District will pay the County Elections Officer for such services pursuant to the terms of the joint contract.

3. General Election Day- Common Polling Places; Voting Precincts

The general election shall be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2017 within and throughout the respective territories of both the County and the District at which all residents, qualified electors of the respective entities, shall be entitled to vote. The hours during which the polling places are to be open at the election shall be from 7:00 o'clock a.m. to 7:00 o'clock p.m.

Except as otherwise provided herein, the polling place for each voting precinct and the voting precincts for the Election and the boundaries thereof are as follows:

4. PRECINCT JUDGES AND CLERKS

The presiding and alternate election judges and clerks for the respective polling places identified in Section 2 of this Order shall be appointed pursuant to the terms of the joint election contract between County, District, and the Brooks County Elections Officer.

A. Ballots and Forms

Voters shall be given a single ballot containing the offices at a particular polling place for each political subdivision. The ballots shall conform to the requirements of the Texas Election Code. The forms used and records maintained at the common polling place in this joint election will be combined in a manner convenient and adequate to record and report the results of the election for each of the participating political subdivisions.

6. DELIVERY OF VOTED BALLOTS; COUNTING; TABULATION

The election officers appointed by the County Election Officer pursuant to the contract between the County, District, and County Election Officer, shall deliver the ballot containers to the central counting station, and the County Election officer shall provide all tabulating services, and make a written return of the Election results to both the City and the District in accordance with the Texas Election Code.

7. CANVASSING OF RETURNS; DECLARING RESULTS

The governing bodies of each entity shall canvass their own returns and declare the results of the Election.

8. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Joint Election Agreement shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by governing body of the County and District respectively.

9. COSTS

- a. County and School District shall each pay its own *pro rata* share of the actual cost of posting and/or publication of the election notices, printing the ballots and election supplies; renting the voting machines at each respective polling location for the election; and the *pro rata* cost of the early voting workers and

election day workers appointed by the County Elections Officer, pursuant to the contract between the County , District, and County Election Officer.

~~b. County and District shall share equally the actual cost of the election workers.~~

In the event that either party cancels it election, such party shall be liable for only its share of election costs incurred up to the date that it canceled its election.

10 MISCELLANEOUS

- a. In connection with the performance of this Agreement, neither of the contracting parties will be deemed liable to third parties for any default of the other contracting party in connection with holding the election, including the failure of a contracting party to pay any expenses under this Agreement.
- b. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and under Chapter 271 the Texas Election Code and all obligations of the parties are performable in Brooks County, Texas.
- c. In case any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue to be valid, and the Agreement shall be construed as if the invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision has never been included.
- d. All amendments, modifications, or alternations must be in writing, dated after the effective date of the Agreement, and approved by the respective governing bodies.
- e. In connection with the Agreement, all notices, inquiries, and communications shall be to the following persons or offices:
