- 5. The student and parent/guardian understand and agree that the Falfurrias High School is responsible for the following with respect to the student:
  - a. The right of direction and control over the student, and maintaining all educational records related to the student;
  - b. Instructing and requiring the student to conform to policies and procedures generally applicable to the training to which the student is assigned, to the extent such policies concern safety and health and/or personal and professional conduct (including the wearing of an identification badge or personal protective equipment and adhering to facility regulations and general safety practices or procedures);
  - c. Implementing and administering policies and practices related to the recruitment, testing, selection, orientation, training, evaluation, replacement, disciplining, and termination of the student;
  - d. Promptly reporting any accident, injury, or occupational illness involving the student to the parent and the business partner, if such injury is alleged to have occurred in connection with the performance of training duties at the business.

- 6. The local business, parent/guardian and student understand that the business is responsible for:
  - e. Complying with all Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) rules and regulations, and any other applicable federal and/or state laws;
  - f. Providing Falfurrias High School and the student with policies generally applicable to any facility to which the student is assigned, to the extent such policies concern safety and health and/or personal and professional conduct (including the wearing of an identification badge or personal protective equipment and adhering to facility regulations and general safety practices or procedures), and;
  - g. Promptly reporting any accident, injury, or occupational illness involving any student to Falfurrias High School.

### II. CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

1. All information provided to Falfurrias High School or the student by the business shall be regarded as confidential and shall not otherwise be disclosed by Falfurrias High School or the student and parent, except with the prior written consent of the business. Confidential Information shall mean all information obtained by or disclosed to Falfurrias High School, Falfurrias School's employees or the student which relates to research, development, business information and/or business activities, including, but not limited to, customer and supplier lists, customer or patient information, pricing, policies, procedures, products, methods of manufacture, processes, and/or other trade secrets, confidential information or trade secret information of third parties in possession of the business and/or the results of service or work by Falfurrias High School or the student for or on behalf of the business.

Confidential information shall not include information that is previously known to or is independently developed by Falfurrias High School with no resources of the business, information that is publicly disclosed either prior to or subsequent to Falfurrias High School's receipt of such information through no fault of Falfurrias High School, or is required to be disclosed pursuant to judicial or administrative process or other requirements of law.

2. The local business agrees to maintain the confidentiality of the student as set forth under the Federal Educational Rights and Privacy Act ("FERPA") as a student enrolled in the Falfurias High School and the training program.

### III, INDEMNIFICATION AND MISCELLANOUS TERMS

- 1. <u>Injury Claims</u>. The student and parent/guardian understand that if the student is injured during the course and scope of the student's training assignment at the business, the business will handle the claim in accordance with local, state and federal policies and procedures. The student/parent guardian agree that the Falfurrias Independent School District shall not be liable for any such injuries and they further agree to hold the District harmless from any such claims for damages.
- 2. INDEMNITY AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY AGREEMENT THE CONTRARY, THE STUDENT AND/OR THE STUDENT'S OR PROVISION TO PARENT/GUARDIAN, AS ACKNOWLEDGED BELOW, AGREE TO INDEMNIFY, DEFEND AND HOLD HARMLESS THE BROOKS CO. INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, FALFURRIS HIGH SCHOOL, AND/OR THE BUSINESS PARTNER, AND THEIR PARENT, AFFILIATES, AND SUBSIDIARY ENTITIES, AND THEIR DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, ATTORNEYS, SUCCESSORS, AND ASSIGNEES FROM ANY LIABILITY, LOSS, COSTS (INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION ATTORNEYS' AND EXPERT FEES), DAMAGES, TAXES, ASSESSMENTS, PENALTIES, OR INTEREST PAYMENTS THAT MAY AT ANY TIME BE INCURRED BY REASON OF ANY LOSS, DEMAND, CHARGE OF DISCRIMINATION, PROCEEDING, ACTION, OR SUIT BROUGHT AGAINST THE SCHOOL DISTRICT AND/OR THE BUSINESS PARTNER OR THEIR DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, ATTORNEYS, SUCCESSORS, AND ASSIGNEES ARISING OUT OF OR IN ANY MANNER RELATED TO: i) THE TRAINING OR INTERNSHIP PROVIDED HEREIN; ii) THIS AGREEMENT; iii) THE ACTS OR OMISSIONS OF STUDENT, iv) ANY CLAIM FOR PERSONAL INJURY TO STUDENT'S FAMILY, REPRESENTATIVE, GUARDIAN OR PARENTS; AND/OR v) ANY CLAIM FOR BREACH BY STUDENT OR OF ANY OF THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT.

LIKEWISE, THE FALFURRIAS HIGH SCHOOL AND THE LOCAL BUSINESS, AS ACKNOWLEDGED BELOW, AGREE TO INDEMNIFY, DEFEND AND HOLD EACH OTHER HARMLESS, AND THEIR PARENT, AFFILIATES, AND SUBSIDIARY ENTITIES, AND THEIR DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, ATTORNEYS, SUCCESSORS, AND ASSIGNEES FROM ANY LIABILITY, LOSS, COSTS (INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION ATTORNEYS' AND EXPERT FEES), DAMAGES, TAXES, ASSESSMENTS, PENALTIES, OR INTEREST PAYMENTS THAT MAY AT ANY TIME BE INCURRED BY REASON OF ANY LOSS, DEMAND, CHARGE OF DISCRIMINATION, PROCEEDING, ACTION, OR SUIT BROUGHT AGAINST THE SCHOOL DISTRICT AND/OR THE BUSINESS PARTNER OR THEIR DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, ATTORNEYS, SUCCESSORS, AND ASSIGNEES ARISING OUT OF OR INANY MANNER RELATED TO THE TRAINING OR INTERNSHIP PROVIDED HEREIN AND/OR THIS AGREEMENT.

3. Benefit Plans. The parent/guardian and student agree that he/she shall be ineligible to participate in any employee benefit plan or fringe benefit program sponsored by the business.

- 4. Severability. In the event that any provision of this agreement conflicts with the law under which this agreement is to be construed or if any such provision is held invalid or rendered void, voidable or unenforceable for any reason, including but not limited to violation of public policy or Texas law and/or is held unconscionable by an arbitrator or a court with jurisdiction over the parties, such provision shall be deemed to be restated to reflect as nearly as possible the original intentions of the parties in accordance with applicable law. The remainder of this agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 5. Entire Agreement. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between all the parties below and supersedes any prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, or negotiations between them with respect to the subject matter hereof, except when the business, Falfurrias High School, student and parent/guardian are subject to a training addendum agreed upon by all parties. Any modifications to this agreement can only be made in writing signed by all parties. Failure of any party to enforce a specific provision of the training agreement shall not be construed as a general relinquishment or a waiver of that provision or of any other provision of this agreement.
- 6. Governing Law and Enforcement. This agreement shall be construed and governed by the laws of the State of Texas and is made and performable in Brooks County, Texas. Venue of any claim or dispute shall be in Falfurrias, Brooks County, Texas.
