- Mr. Patroelj suggested for next year to include \$5,000.00 for the Civil Defense Line item to allow during emergency times, for employees to be paid for man hours worked. Judge Barrera suggested to place \$10,000.00 for that line item.
- Suggested to include the increase to equal \$45,000.00 for Adam and if not agreed on the contract, then monies stays there.
- Discussed the Airport contract —concern of the mowing at the airport and should have a meeting to discuss the contract.
