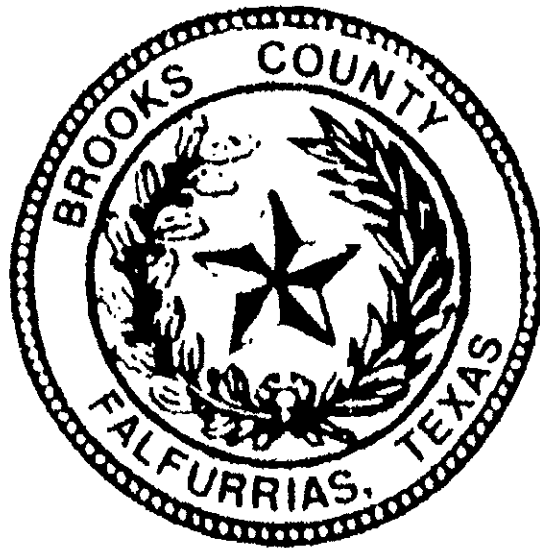

The Court may vote and/or act upon each of the items listed in this Agenda. **Executive Sessions**; The Commissioners Court of Brooks County, Falfurrias, Texas, reserves the right to adjourn into Executive Session at any time during the course of this meeting to discuss any of the matters listed, as authorized by Texas Government Code, including, but not limited to: Sections 551.071(Consultation with Attorney), 551.072 (Deliberations about Real Property), 551.073 (Deliberations about Gifts and Donations), 661.074 (Personnel Matters), 551.076 (Deliberations about Security Devices), 551.087 (Economic Development), 418.183 (Deliberations about Homeland Security Issues), and as authorized by the Texas Tax Code, including, but not limited to, Section 321.3022 (Sales Tax Information), whenever it is considered necessary and legally justified under Open Meetings Act. As authorized by Section 551.071 (2) of the Texas Government Code, this meeting may be convened into Executive Session for the purpose of seeking confidential legal advice from the County Attorney on any agenda item listed herein. 1. Public Notice and Statement of Emergency

Pursuant to Section 551.045 of the Texas Government Code, this meeting is called with more than one hour but less than seventy-two hours' notice to consider a matter of emergency or urgent public necessity requiring a meeting under said statutory provision is as follows:

Governor Greg Abbott issued a statewide disaster declaration for Texas and USDA officials confirmed a positive New World screwworm case in a 3-week-old calf in La Pryor, TX. This marks the first confirmed U.S. case since 1966. The state and federal response is actively working to contain the spread.

While there are no confirmed screwworm cases in Brooks County, South Texas is considered a high-risk buffer zone. Because of its geographical location Brooks County should implement enhanced safety measures immediately:

2. Public Comments

- a. Open to the public with limits as indicated above.

3. Presentation of NWS information to include the latest updates.

4. Discuss, Consider and Act to approve Local Declaration of Disaster regarding the threat of New World Screwworm in Brooks County, Texas.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

5. Brooks County Commissioner Court reserves the right to convene in an Executive Session closed to the public at any time during the course of this meeting to discuss matters authorized by the Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, such as §551.071 (Consultation with Attorney) or §551.074 (Personnel Matters) as related to the Declaration of Local Disaster regarding the threat of New Screwworm in Brooks County, TX.
