- * went over the expenditures and revenues thru the next 6 months and the possibility of leaving the County short \$190,000.00 due to the closure of offices
- * discussed having a meeting with elected officials to discuss if needed in cuts; discussed a meeting within 2 weeks being the 28th to discuss a follow up
