Vote: Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote (**summary:** Yes = 5).

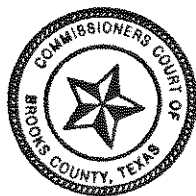


